**Al-Huson Town in the Late Ottoman Era until Al-Taswia Era 1890-1936
 Economical and Sociological Reading Based on Ottoman Financial Records**

ABSTRACT

The study tries to present a documentary reading of the development of Al-Huson village in Ajloun province between the Ottoman period (1890-1918), passing through the Faisalian period (1918-1920) tending with the era of the East-Jordan- Emirate during 1921 and 1936. The study stops in the year 1936 with the period of land settlements. The study uses a new neither to unused source, which is the financial record used in 1890 by the financial dept. of Ajloun province, and which continued to be used during the aforementioned periods. The record documents the architectural activity, the utility and the civilians in such away that makes this study add minute detail, that observe the changes in the movements of populations and architecture in an attempt to read the development of the Jordanian countryside in the aforementioned period; it focuses upon civil institutions to the complete the work done by previous studies and to update them using this new source.

Methodologically speaking, the study aims to use statistics and computers to emphasise the importance of shifting modern historical studies to a new state that observes the economic history and the social developments and makes use of available technology and relies on comparing used sources in previous studies with the financial record. The study inferred that this area is linked to the Asyrian society and that Al-Huson village, during the study period, represents a miniature of the social movement that the period of the Emirate witnessed with momentum during the period of its foundation and that of Land Settlements.
